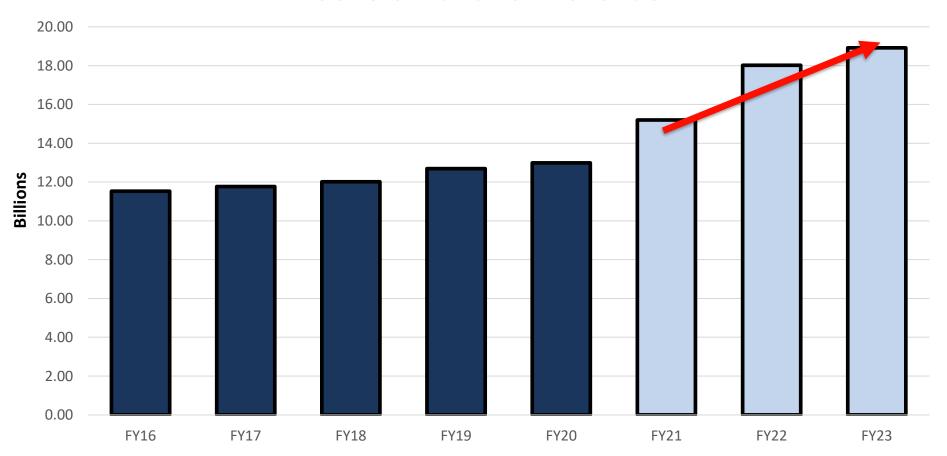

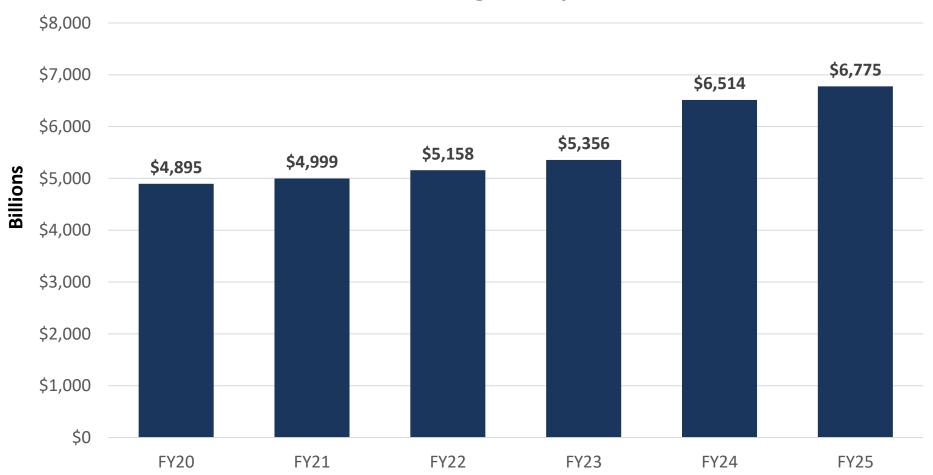
General Fund Tax Revenue





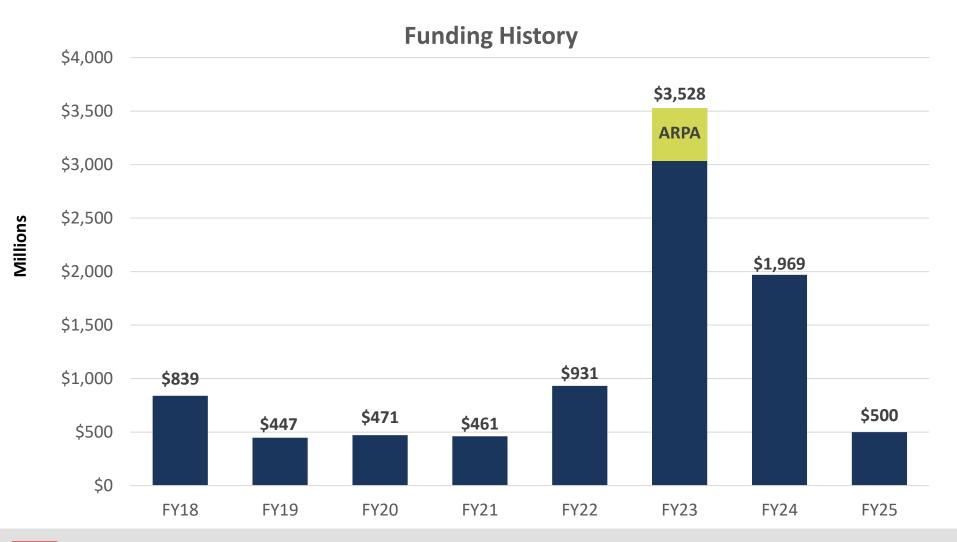

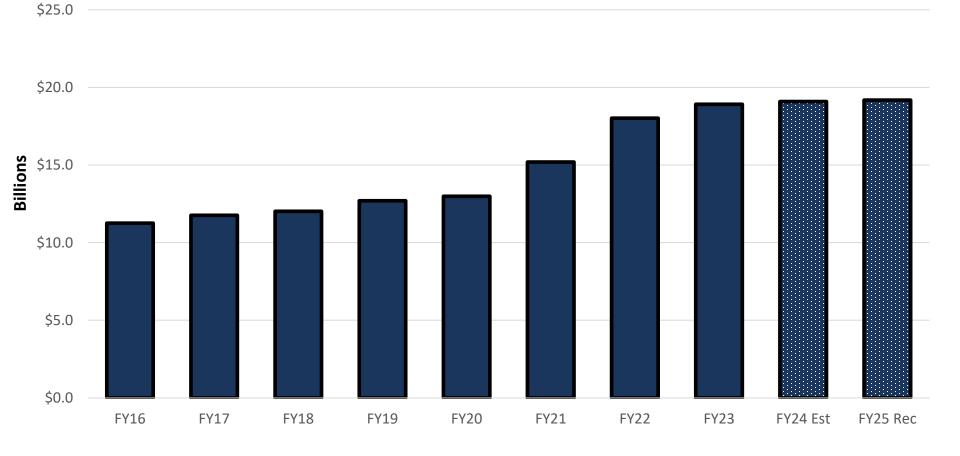

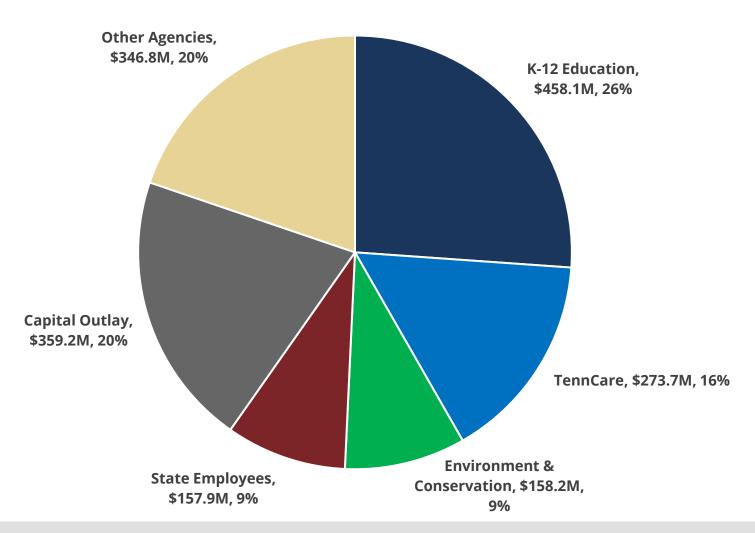
